Winemaker's Notes

Viognier is one of the preeminent white grapes grown in the Rhone region of France. The 2014 Desert Wind Viognier has strong floral aromas and flavors of peach, citrus zest, vanilla and a touch of lemongrass with crisp acidity and a lingering, spicy finish. Enjoy a glass by itself or pair with food; it partners especially well with shellfish, pork, and Asian cuisine.

Vineyard Notes

The Culloden Vineyard is located in Eastern Washington's Horse Heaven Hills viticultural area, which encompasses 25% of the planted vineyards in the state. The Horse Heaven Hills takes its name from the wild horses that used to roam the area decades ago. Culloden Vineyard features south-facing slopes and deep, well drained soils, which result in wines of distinct character and flavor.

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
